Requirements for Washington, D.C. Undergraduate Scholarship Award

Applicants must be minority students who will be enrolled full-time in an AACSB accredited undergraduate business or management program in a college or university in the U.S. as of September 2008. Eligible students must currently reside in Washington D.C., Maryland or Virginia (either permanently or as a student).

1. Applicants must submit a two to five page, double-spaced, type-written essay in response to **one** of the following topics:

"How would you describe the causes of fluctuations in the U.S. economy?"

"If you were elected the next President in November 2008, what would be on your agenda to stimulate the economy?"

2. Applicants must submit an official stamped college transcript with their application.
3. A completed application, essay and official transcript must be postmarked by **May 31, 2008** and submitted to:
